Driving Distance

Staying through the weekend? Here are some suggestions:

- Head to nearby **Point Loma** – visit the **Old Point Loma Lighthouse** or go tidepooling at the **Cabrillo National Monument National Park**. <http://www.nps.gov/cabr/index.htm>. Have lunch or dinner at Point Loma Seafoods, or Miguel's.
- Cross the bridge to **Coronado** and visit the famous **Hotel Del** (Hotel Del) <http://www.hoteldel.com/> and then take a walk on the beach.
- Visit Balboa Park, including multiple museums (check the calendar at the website for museum exhibits and events <http://www.balboapark.org/>) and the world famous San Diego Zoo.
- Head north to **La Jolla**. Visit the La Jolla cove, visit the seals at Casa Beach, and check out the Birch Aquarium. There are many dining options on Prospect Street, overlooking the ocean.
- Check out the **Old Town Arts Festival**, October 5-6. While you are there visit the **Junípero Serra Museum**, atop the hill in Presidio Park. It was here in 1769 that a Spanish Franciscan missionary, Father Junípero Serra established Alta California's first mission and presidio (fort). Open weekends Saturday and Sunday, 10 am-4pm (call to ensure no weddings going on http://www.sandiegohistory.org/serra_museum.html)
- Visit wine country in **Temecula Valley** <http://www.temeculawines.org/>, where there are over 35 wineries, as well as restaurants and lodging.
