## Embarcadero/Waterfront (walking distance)

**Description:** Located along Broadway and stretching towards the Broadway Pier on San Diego Bay. The Embarcadero is a nice place to enjoy the waterfront – stroll along the ocean, catch a harbor cruise, tour the USS Midway and Maritime Museum or shop/be entertained at Seaport Village.

**How to get there from the Hilton Bayfront:** ~ 1 mile walk along Marina Parkway and Convention Way. Or take the trolley – Green Line to Seaport Village or Santa Fe Depot.
