## Old Town (via trolley ~ 30 min)

<b>El Campo Cemetery</b>		2410 San Diego Avenue	San Diego's first catholic cemetery, restored to its original appearance during the 1850's. Native Americans, state lawmakers, (some law breakers), early pioneers and the town's first mayor all rest here.

The Old Town State Historical Park maintains a collection of 19th century homes and businesses including restored original historic buildings from, and some reconstructed sites. Also museums, retail shops, and restaurants.

The Travel Channel's <i>America's Most Haunted</i> claims it is the #1 most haunted house in the U.S. <b>Ask the docents about their own ghost experiences!</b> Sun-Tue 10 am-5 pm; Thu-Sat 10 am-9:30 pm. Closed Wed.
